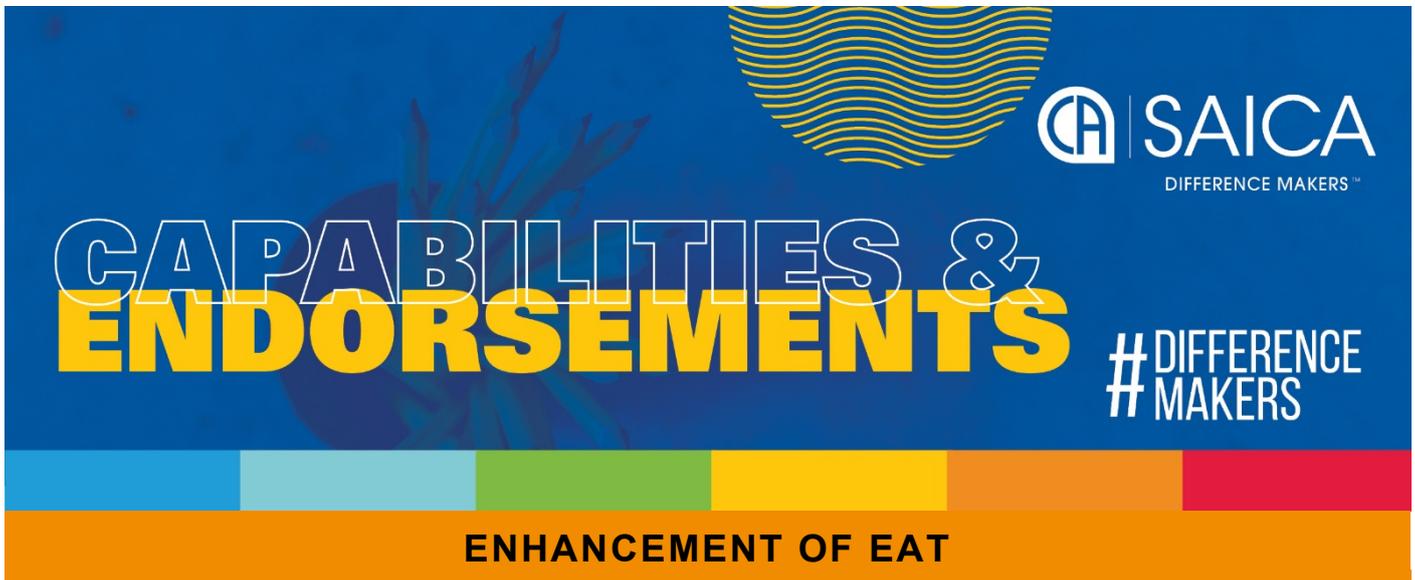

Subject: Upcoming enhancements of the SAICA EAT

Dear Training Officers and Training Office Administrators,

Following the engagement sessions held earlier this year and feedback received from training offices, SAICA has been **working closely with the EAT development team to prioritise and implement a series of enhancements** to the current Electronic Assessment Tool (EAT).

We are pleased to confirm that **development of the first batch of enhancements is now underway**.

This batch includes a set of **high-impact improvements identified through user feedback and internal review**. These items are being developed in phases and will be released progressively as each feature is completed and tested.

Key Enhancements in progress:

Deleting assessment instruments

Functionality for Training Officers and Training Office Administrators to delete LORs and PDSs, with a full audit log of deleted instruments.

Hiding the removed PVAA learning outcomes

Alignment with the revised competency framework, reducing PVAA learning outcomes from 95 to 45. The removed learning outcomes will be hidden on training plans, reports, LORs and PDSs.

Enhancements related to levels of proficiency

Limit ratings so they do not exceed SAICA's required final level of proficiency, display the required level of proficiency on assessment instruments and show the rating path selected on the previous PDS.

Consolidated view for all role-players

Providing reviewers, evaluators, and assessors with an easy way to identify where they have assessment instruments awaiting their action across their assigned training offices.

Enhanced access within the signed-in Training Office

Enabling reviewers, evaluators and assessors to track the progress of assessment instruments they have been assigned to within their signed-in Training Office, even when the instrument is no longer awaiting their action.

Reports and exports

Updates to monitoring reports to include initial assessment and evaluation dates, and the ability to export LORs, PDSs and cumulative PVAA evidence.

LOR Acumen Feedback

Adding an optional field on the LOR for Reviewer Feedback on the Acumens when the reviewer agrees with the proposed rating provided by the trainee.

These enhancements form part of a broader, phased improvement plan aimed at improving usability, aligning EAT with the revised competency framework, and enhancing efficiency for training offices and trainees.

Further communication will follow as development progresses, including release timelines, feature-specific updates, and user guidance ahead of each rollout.
